



6 DAYS SAFARI

OL PEJETA - NAIVASHA - MAASAI MARA

DAY 1.



06:00 - Pick up from your hotel and start the drive towards Nanyuki where Ol Pejeta Conservancy is located. The drive will take approximately 6hrs with stops in between for bathrooms, a bit of shopping in the supermarket and at the Equator sign where you will have a chance to take a photo as you cross from the southern to the northern hemisphere.

13:00 - Arrive to Ol Pejeta and a short drive after checking into the conservancy at the gate leads you to the camp where a hot lunch will be served. You will then have some time to relax and unwind before you go out for your game drive later in the day.

16:00 - Your first game drive in Ol Pejeta. The conservancy is famous for its spectacular views of Mount Kenya on a clear day, healthy population of both black and white rhinos, all the big cats as well as other species of mammals and birds.

18:30 - Head back to camp for your evening meal and overnight in Ol Pejeta.

DAY 2

Full day in Ol Pejeta Conservancy. You will have the chance to visit the only Chimpanzee sanctuary in Kenya, the endangered species boma where you will get a chance to see and learn about the last three surviving Northern White rhinos in the world and visit Baraka the blind black rhino and feed him. There will be game drives in between all these activities as well.

Night game drives are also an added attraction in Ol Pejeta so if you wish to see some of the nocturnal wildlife and activity in the bush, then this could be arranged for you as well at an additional cost.



DAY 3

06:00 - Early breakfast and after check out, we depart for Lake Naivasha. The drive will take us through the Kenyan highlands and we will have brief bathroom stops, a stop at Thompson's Falls in Nyahururu before we arrive in Naivasha for lunch.

Naivasha we treat as an overnight stop before we push for Mara the next day. However, it has its charm which is the lake. A numerous variety of water birds make Lake Naivasha a fabulous birding destination. The lake is also home to hippos, crocodiles and many other bird species like the African fish eagle, great white pelicans and many more. A boat trip around the lake can be organized for you at an additional fee whereby you will be taken around the lake for a close up encounter with the wildlife that can be found in and around Lake Naivasha.

Dinner and overnight in Naivasha.

DAY 4



06:00 - Early morning breakfast before check out

road so we have to make up the time by leaving early.

A brief stop at Narok town for refueling and shopping for those who want to replenish their supplies are an order before we proceed of into the Mara plains.

13:00 - Arrive for lunch after a game drive en route to the camp. You will have time to relax and rest before you go out again for the evening game drive.

16:00 - Leave for your first game drive in Maasai Mara and enjoy the abundance of wildlife and the amazing views of the rolling plains. Enjoy the sun setting before heading back to camp/lodge around 18:30 for your evening meal and overnight.

DAY 5

Full day in Maasai Mara.

There is an option of a taking a hot air balloon ride on this second day in Maasai Mara which is at an additional cost. This includes a champagne breakfast after the flight which take approximately 1 hour. We shall then organize with the balloon flight company and pick you at an agreed point and you can either continue on a game drive or be taken back to the lodge/camp for a bit of rest before heading back out later in the day.

A cultural visit to a Maasai village can also be arranged on this day if you desire to learn a thing or two about the Maasai way of life and culture. This is also at an additional cost.



DAY 6.

Last Day on the itinerary. Since it is a long drive back to Nairobi, the day starts with an early breakfast followed by a departure at 07:00 with a game drive en route to the exit gate. The drive should take approximately 7 hours. You will be dropped at your desired final drop off point which could be the airport or a hotel in Nairobi.
